Background

The American National Standard for High-Visibility Safety Apparel, ANSI/ISEA 107-2004, was approved on September 15, 2004. This standard specifies performance requirements for background and retroreflective materials, test methods, minimum amounts, placement, and care labeling. Certificates of compliance produced by a certified, third-part test house are required for both the background and retroreflective materials.
